The Charity was also able to maintain its commitment to extending special invites to 10 men and women who have had a cancer diagnosis, as part of their recovery journey.

The Teenage Cancer Trust was nominated as the main beneficiaries from the proceeds of the event. Keynote speaker Sue Morgan (Teenage Cancer Trust Nurse Consultant) delivered a thought provoking, light-hearted yet powerful speech on the work of Teenage Cancer Trust and the brave and interesting young people and their families she has met during her many years as a nurse. She went on to thank everyone present for their attendance and support, highlighting the positive impact donations have on young people and their families.

The Ball raised in excess of £3,400 and Beyond Cancer was humbled by the level of responses and support received from local businesses and individuals who donated their time and raffle prizes, regardless of the pressures of the current financial climate.
